

- 1. The Junior Fair Queen contest is open to single girls between the ages of 11 14 as of September 1, 2025, who are residents of Colorado Co. and attend public, private, or home school.
- 2. Contestants pay an entry fee of \$50.00, provided by a Sponsor (civic club, business, school, or service group) Contestants may select a sponsor or be selected by a sponsor. A HEADSHOT photo is required, with permission to be used in media.
- 3. Contestants are required to sell a minimum of 25 Season Passes to the fair. Contestants are encouraged to sell as many Season tickets and Carnival passes as possible, as the Contestant who has the highest ticket sales will receive a gift card. Sponsors may assist contestants with sales.
- 4. Contestants are expected to represent Colorado County by attending Fair functions throughout the year, as well as ride on the Colorado Co. Fair Float in 80% of area parades. Also, Parents are responsible for helping with maintenance and decoration of the fair float for area parades, and to pull float, if necessary.
- 5. Contestants should be in good standing within the school and community and promote a positive image for themselves and Colorado County. Contestants must be single, never married, nor have given birth, or expecting a child. A contestant must be of good moral character and not engage in inappropriate or illegal activities that would be an embarrassment to the Fair Association or community of Colorado County. Activities that promote profanity, nudity, illegal drugs, alcohol, or inappropriate social media posts will result in forfeiture of title and awards. The Board of Directors reserves the right to make the final decision.
- 6. The contest will take place on Sat., September 6, '25 at the Colorado County Fair Grounds "Founders' Hall" BLDG., following the Jr. Miss Contest (around 6:30 pm), and consist of two parts: a private interview, and a public interview with out-of-county judges while in FORMAL WEAR attire. Judges' decisions are final.
- 7. Contestants may sign up and get more info. Tues. June 24 or Wed June 25 at the Fairgrounds from 4-6 p.m., or online-see rules and get season/carnival tickets to sell. Deadline to enter: Fri.
